"skinned up to the ridge and observed 5-9 inches of new and accumulating snow forming into wind drifts that were highly reactive. Multiple remote triggers occurred while traveling N on the ridge, propagating both on W and E faces of the ridge. Both Hidden and Northwest Passage slid with little effort down to an icy <u>bed surface</u>. Debris at bottom of hidden was substantial but great skiing."
