

A natural $\underline{\text{wind slab}}$ avalanche beneath a $\underline{\text{cornice}}$ on Henderson Mountain, near Cooke City. It appears to have broken at the new-old interface, 2-3 ft deep and ~300 ft wide. Likely ran overnight on Monday 2/22/21 or early morning Tuesday 2/23/21.
