Skiers in Cooke City noted this natural storm <u>slab</u> that released on an east <u>aspect</u> at 9000' on March 9th. It broke 6" deep and 25' wide. A second <u>slide</u> was triggered by a mountain goat on a southwest-facing slope, about 1' deep and 25' wide.

Another 1' deep slide was reported on the south face of Meridian Peak at 9500'.
